9. How would you proceed to lead a person to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ?
10. Explain how a preacher should go about accepting a call from a church and how he should proceed in leaving a church.
11. How do you feel about a preacher handling his finances?
12. Do you use tobacco in any form or alcoholic beverages?
13. Are you willing to devote your full time to the ministry as the Lord opens doors of opportunity?
14. Do you believe in and practice tithing?

6. Does the Bible teach that Christ was truly man as well as truly God? Explain.
7. According to 2John 9-11, what should be our treatment of those who deny the deity or humanity of Christ?
8. Do you think in the light of Scripture we should readily excommunicate from our midst either layman or preacher who would deny the deity or humanity of Christ?
9. How far should we go in cooperation with other churches who are not orthodox in belief?
10. What is repentance? How is it related to salvation? Is it essential?
11. What is saving faith?
12. What is the new birth? Why is it necessary?
13. What do we mean by depravity? Do you believe infants who die are saved?
14. What part does the Holy Spirit play in conversion (the new birth)?
