SCFWB Clerk (Tommy Hill) gave the report of all the executive board meetings that were held during the past year and also the general board meeting from 2-24-16. All the details of these meeting are located in the SC Minutes. Motion was made to receive the report. MSC

Motion was made to have a flexible agenda. MSC

Bro. Stanley Rajkumar (Pastor from South India) was introduced to the state association.

Bro. Johnny Evans gave the Committee on Committee's report. To serve on the Nominating committee: Mike Wilson (TL), Waylon Owens (SCC), Bruce Jones (EC), Tim Larrimore (BC)-Chairman, Marty Cox (CA). To serve on the Resolutions committee: John Cody (TL), Joey Postlewaite (SCC)-Chairman, John Matthews (EC), Jeremy Overstreet (BC), Chris Johnson (CA). Motion made to accept report. MSC

Bro. Chris Todd gave the Executive Secretary report for the state office and bookstore. The following motion was made: It is recommended by the Executive Board and therefore moved that the SCFWB State Association, in light of recent catastrophic events, such as the SC flood of 2015, establish a Disaster Relief Board and Relief Fund for the purpose of assisting FWB Churches as well as the

general public to promote the welfare of FWB and to extend the gospel to whosoever will. This board shall consist of both laymen and preachers and shall have their own budget and by-laws and will operate under the constitution of the SCFWB State Association. This board will report annually to the SCFWB State Association and will be eligible for support under the SC Plan of Support. The following persons are nominated to serve on this board. This board will be comprised of the following members: Tim Owens (Inman FWB), Jeff Bazen (Millbranch FWB), Steve Brodgen (Peace FWB), Tim Larrimore (Liberty FWB), Bob Biddix (Lebanon FWB), David Stevens (White Savannah FWB) and Brian Webb (Fairview FWB). Motion to accept this proposal and lay it on the table until the afternoon session. MSC

Bro. Todd continued with the report for the State Office and SCFWB State Bookstore. Details were given regarding the addition of a coffee shop in the bookstore. Bro. Chris introduced the new state website. The SC Plan of Support saw an increase of approximately \$30,000 from the previous year. Much of the increase is attributable to outside organizations giving for disaster relief. All details on budgets reported on are located in the minutes. Motion was made to accept the report. MSC

This returns to a past plan where monies given can be sent to the missionary of choice. All monies that go into a missionaries account stay in that missionaries account. International Missions ended 2015 in the black. Missionaries present gave brief statements regarding their work. Sis. Mirael Gainer gave information on Japan and Bro. Jonathan Postlewaite provided some information on the work in Bulgaria. A letter was read from Bro. Neil & Mandy Morgan. Bro. Carlise Hanna was thanked for his shining example and he was given a gift to commemorate his years of service to India. Motion made to receive report. MSC

Bro. Kenneth Ackers, Director of Master's Men Ministries brings greetings from Bro. David Crowe, director of North American Ministries. The Master's Men now falls under the direction of the Home Missions North American Ministries department. Master's Men helped roof a facility in Castle Rock in Utah during 2015. Expressed excitement in the SC FWB involvement in training and disaster response and the opportunity to assist in SC, KY, and TN during the year. Master's Men offers 18 different Bible studies for men's groups to use. Hispanic ministries are going well. Bro. Rick Bowling is currently working with 43 different works in this field. There are over 3000 Hispanic brothers/sisters who gather weekly to worship throughout America in our Hispanic outreach. Bro. Ranson works with our church planters and there are 50 planters serving in 35 different works with over 2000 meeting weekly for worship. The church planters saw over 400 decisions for Christ during 2015. The NAM also works with military chaplains and we currently have a total of 8 serving in the military (5 Army, 1 Navy, 1 National Guard, and 1 Army Reserve with 4 men in the process of joining this group).

We are excited about the church growth and leadership seminars. A Power Conf. was held in Branson, Mo. with over 300 in attendance. The Power Conf. scheduled for 2016 is, "Hands Held High," and will be held in Pigeon Forge, Tn. on May 30-31. Motion made to receive report as information. MSC

Bro. Todd Smith spoke regarding the end of life planning helps that are being offered through the Board of Retirement and introduced Bro. David Brown, who encouraged all to consider tithing on our estates. The Foundation offers programs in Planned Giving and Estate Planning Ministry. The Foundation has been able to speak in over 200 churches providing help to over 1100 families. It is estimated that around 11.5 million dollars has been planned to be left to ministries. We have acquired the Maggie House in Charleston, Ak. and it opened in Dec. 01, 2015 with 30 children. The Chaffee Crossing children's home in Fort Smith, Ak. will serve 33 children. God blessed with the purchase of the Curt, Cliff and Opal Young Family Home by providing 20 acres for \$5K per acre. Gifts of \$100,000 and 1.5 million were received to assist in the needs for this property. In the Hope Center there were 97 babies born during 2015. God is greatly blessing the FWB Family Ministries and we are available and would love to come visit at your churches and present what we do and how you can be a part of God's plan in these efforts. Report received as information.

A report was given by the Falcon Children's home regarding the purchase of the FWB Children's home in Turbeville. He provided reports of how God has worked in all that has transpired in the sale of our children's home. Report received as information.

SCFWB HOME MISSIONS BOARD MINUTES

June 18, 2015, 10 a.m. - Meeting at the State Office
Bro. Allan Austin opened in prayer.

Discussion began with Aiken work and how and when we would meet with the Southside Church to look at closing the work because of lack of attendance and funds to keep it operating.

Bro. Chris Todd gave financial report. Southside Church is in the red \$13,481.62. With the closure, we discussed severance package and penalties for early termination of lease. The package \$11,950.00. Closure date was set effective July 5, 2015 with a motion and second it carried.

The board set a date to do an inventory on June 30, 2015.

Met with Bro. Larry Monday at 10:50 am. He stated that there were about eighteen on average in attendance and an increase of about \$1000 in offerings monthly. This was not being put toward his salary and was not helping the status of the situation.

Bro. Larry gave Bro. Chris Todd a list of the utility companies so they could begin to close out accounts.

The board discussed the closure as well as some revitalization for our state.

Mentioned the rezoning of the Pamplico property and that meetings were set for that with the County Planning Commission.

Closed meeting with prayer. Attending: Bro. Mitch Edge (Director), Bro. Chris Johnson (CA), Bro. Larry McAlister (EC), Bro. Tim Larrimore (BC), Bro. Allan Austin (SCC), and Bro. Chris Todd (Executive Director).

September 3, 2015, 10 a.m. - Meeting at the State Office
Bro. Mitch Edge opened in prayer.

There was a financial report given about where the Aiken work was for the year. \$39,000 for 2014 and \$20,000 plus for 2015.

Discussion began with Aiken work reopening with Bro. Randy Valandingham. He has sent a letter expressing his desire to move to Aiken and reopen the work. There were letters of reference and recommendation. Bro. Randy asked the board to pay utilities for six months with no salary. He will get a job and be bi-vocational. He believes that within six months the work will be able to begin paying the utilities and some salary. He gave a list of about forty people who would be willing to come along side him and help with the work. Bro. Randy would meet with the board later to discuss details.

A call was made to Bro. Randy to inform him of the decision. He was thrilled and excited to meet with.

Motion was made to accept his offer and to work with him to reopen the work. We set a meeting with Bro. Randy for September 10, 2015 at 10 a.m. in Aiken.

Guidelines will be according to the request letter from Bro. Randy. A new church constitution will be drawn up for the new church.

Board discussed the options for Pamplico property since it did not receive the rezoning approval. There is a group from Georgetown, SC who wishes to lease the property. They have discussed with Bro. Allan Austin that their work is new and has not established any credit. Therefore, they wish to lease until they can establish credit to purchase the property. They do wish to purchase as soon as they can get credit. A meeting will be set to meet with the group to discuss the lease and draw up a contract. The board wishes to receive \$800 a month and all utilities paid along with insurance. This will total around \$1000 a month that the board will receive in positive cash flow. Hopefully this will offset the expenses in Aiken.

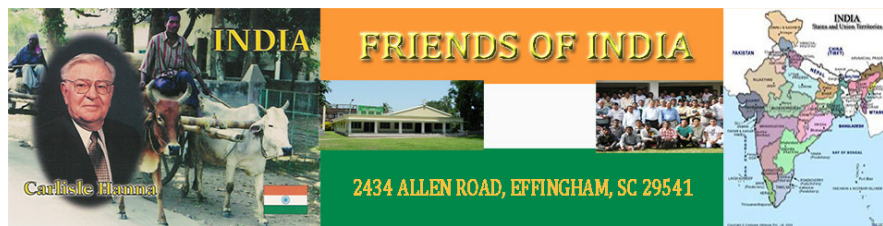
